Feed The Band – Band Camp Band Boosters provide lunch one day during band camp.	20	August	Set-up/Serve: 2 hrs Clean-up: 2 hrs
Band Camp Icy Pops Band camp can be incredibly hot and grueling. Volunteers purchase icy pops and deliver to students at the end of band camp each day.	12	July	Delivery/Distribution: 1-2 hrs
Pool Party JV and Varsity students are invited to a pool party during the 1 st week of band camp. Volunteers donate food, set-up, chaperone, and clean-up.	12	July	Set-up/Clean-Up: 1-2 hrs Chaperone: 2 hrs
Calling Tree Email and Facebook are great ways to share information regarding band activities; however, a phone call adds a personal touch. Band parents volunteer to call members of their student's section throughout the year to ensure all families are informed.	10	Varies	Call Time: 2-3 hrs
Premiere Night This event is held after school starts on a Saturday. A pot luck dinner is held for all band families and band debut's the marching show for the year. Volunteers set-up, manage food tables, and clean-up.	20	Aug	Set-up: 2 hrs Manage Food Tables: 1 hr Clean-up: 2 hrs
March-A-Thon Students march through 1-2 neighborhoods near Millard North HS to raise money to support the band. Families volunteer as guides, to hand out treats to spectators, collection donations, and provide coolers of Gatorade/water along the route.	50-60	Aug	Donate/Deliver Drinks: 1 hr Walk Parade Route: 4-5 hrs
Bus Cookies Students participate in several marching competitions in the Fall. Volunteers donate three dozen cookies to treat the band students on the bus after a long day.	20	Sept-Oct	Bakery Cookies: 1 hr Homemade Cookies: 1-3 hrs
Uniform Fittings There are many components to a marching band uniform. Volunteers staff stations during fittings to assist students with locating items needed (shoes, pants, jackets). NO prior KNOWLEDGE or EXPERIENCE required!	20-25	July-Aug	Fitting Evenings: 2-3 hrs

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Bus Grapes Students participate in several marching competitions in the Fall. Volunteers donate 20 bags of grapes, washed and removed from the stems.	20	Sept-Oct	Purchase/Bag Grapes: 1 hr
Bus Chaperones Student participate in several marching competitions in the Fall. Most are held in the Omaha-metro area. Volunteers accompany the band on the bus, assist with uniforms, and cheer for the band from the stands at the competition.	20	Sept-Oct	Local Competition: 12-18 hrs Out-of-Town: 18-48 hrs
Pit Crew (Roadie) Transporting the necessary equipment to support a complex marching show requires large trucks and many volunteers. Volunteers load/unload large instruments, equipment, and props at school, Buell field, and other competition locations.	15-25	Sept-Oct	Home Football: 5-8 hrs Local Competition: 12-18 hrs Other Competition: 18-48 hrs
Feed the Band – Competitions Band Boosters provide a meal at the Wildcat Classic (Omaha) competition, Blue Springs, and Minneapolis. Volunteers can donate food and assist with transportation and serving the day of the event.	10-15	Sept-Oct	Opportunities TBA
NE State Band Competition Millard North HS and Millard South HS host the NE state band competition each year. Volunteers monitor parking lots, sell concessions, and take tickets at the gate.	60-80	Oct	Opportunities TBA
After-State Party This celebration is held immediately following the state band competition and is free for all students (JV & Varsity). Volunteers donate food, set-up, work the party, and clean-up.	20	Oct	Set-up/Serve: 1 hr Clean-up: 1 hr
Concert Receptions Cookies and drinks are served after each band concert (including 8 th grade side-side). Volunteers donate cookies, set-up, manage the food tables, and clean up.	40	Dec-May	Set-up/Serve: 1 hr Clean-up: 1 hr
Kiewit Solo & Ensemble Competition The Millard North HS band boosters are responsible for the middle school compeition. Volunteers provide food in the judges room and stock/staff the concession stand. Proceeds are used to support band activities throughout the year.	40	Apr-May	Set-up: 2 hrs Shifts: 2 hrs Clean-up: 1 hr
After Prom The Millard North band is responsible for decorating a section of the school using the theme selected each year. Volunteers are needed to help with props, decorating the week before prom, and may sign up to work various shifts the night of the event.	40	Apr-May	Opportunities TBA
Big Band Dance BBD is organized by the boosters and serves as a BIG fundraiser for all band activities throughout the year. Volunteer to donate food, silent auction/raffle items and assist the night of the event.	50	May	Opportunities TBA
